



Step Four

Since you only have a few cut you will start off putting together just a few blocks. Even though I knew what I was making, I still made them one at a time. I found I could work faster one at a time rather than trying to chain... and you will see why shortly.



First sew together two of your 4 1/2 inch pairs.

I only finger pressed and did that to the darker color.



Now add the remaining 4 1/2 inch pieces to one side of each, making triples like this.

I finger pressed the seam allowances to the darker fabric. One set will go one way and the other set the opposite way.
